Camping and Caravanning Site

Water tap

We have supplied a water tap on the wooden fence, next to the ornate water trough with fish. Please do not put anything nasty in the trough as the cows will be using it to drink out of later in the summer.

Washing up area

The washing up area can be found near to the 'tea garden', in the shed next to the big horse trough containing fish. There is a small hot water heater and sink. We have also provided a freezer and refrigerator to use for freezing cold blocks and keeping food and drinks cool. This area has some working heavy horse harnesses on display together with lots of swallow nests in the roof.

Toilets and Showers

The toilets and showers can be accessed from the parking area and they include 1 disabled toilet and shower area. Showers require a £1 coin and this allows for 8 minutes of showering time.

On Departure

Please make sure that you remove all tent pegs, rubbish or sharp objects and check your pitch on leaving. We mow the field and your consideration would be very much appreciated.

Yellow Wheel bin

Please do not leave large **broken** picnic tables or old clothes, wellington boots or broken deck chairs etc. This bin is for small amounts of waste per caravan or tent. Please use the Tissington Trail facility for your bottle and can recycling. There is a recycling centre located at the Tissington Trail for bottles, plastics, cans and paper.

Play Area

Please do **NOT CLIMB ON THE WALLS** or remove stones for propping vans up. The animals are here as part of our dairy production and the heifers are fed twice a day. Children are very welcome to watch feeding, but we respectfully ask that they should be supervised by adults at all times.

Farm Tours

Janet will be pleased to provide a guided tour of the farm upon request. Tours are usually conducted after breakfast (approx 10:30am) or at another mutually convenient time. We are very happy to provide information about farming practice and we make sure that the tours are pitched at a level to suit the group.

Field With Hook-Ups

Chemical Emptying Point

There is a chemical emptying point at the bottom of the field, which is situated next to a large tree trunk and electric post. Please do not put cans etc in this facility, as it can cause restrictions to our tanker equipment. There is a water tap for washing toilets and we would be grateful if you would turn this off when you have finished. **Please use water sparingly and wisely.**

Drinking Water

The drinking water tap is located next to the water trough in the hedge row (nearer to the farm) or, alternatively another tap is situated on the fence by the drive. **Again we would request that the tap is switched off securely and children must be supervised at all times to make sure that this is actioned.**

The Shower and Toilet

These can be accessed from the small tea garden. Showers require a £1 coin and this allows for 8 minutes of showering time. There is 1 disabled toilet and shower area, with wheelchair access.

Hot Tub
